

Literacy:

This term we will look at different types of Traditional Fairy Tales and Rhymes. Our focus will be on The Little Red Hen. In phonics we will be looking at phase 2 phonemes e g s a t p i n d o c k e u r There will also be a phonics workshop for parents.

Maths:

This term we shall look at counting and ordering numbers to 10. Finding ways to represent numbers using fingers, marks on paper or pictures.

We shall continue to have daily maths inputs focusing on problem solving, shape and patterns, as well as addition and subtraction.

Small world:

In small world play the children will create their own farm scenarios and use puppets to tell stories.

Personal and Social Development:

We will build up on making friendships by talking to each other and showing sensitivity to other people's feelings. Continuing to think about co-operating and making the right choices and understanding consequences to create a positive learning environment.

Understanding the world and Expressive arts and design:

Children will be learning about their world through the topic and will be:

- Thinking about our local environment and where we live.
- Designing and building a windmill.
- Looking at our local community and people who help us.
- Completing activities to do with Remembrance Sunday.
- Thinking about what the weather is like in autumn.
- Exploring other cultures with a focus upon celebrations looking at similarities and differences.
- Continuing to look after our environment creating habitats and looking for wildlife.

Outdoor learning:

We love to learn outside. Please ensure your child attends school prepared for all weathers. In preparation for the cold weather please ensure your child has named wellies and raincoat to keep in school. This term we will be creating our own bug hotel and looking after our plants and vegetables.

Physical Development:

This term we shall be starting weekly PE sessions these will be held on Mondays.

RE:

This term we shall focus upon generosity and think how we can support our local community. We shall also think about how to care for and look after our own environment.

Communication and Language:

We shall continue with our daily 'check ins' to allow children to freely communicate how they are feeling.

We will share news and become aware of a listeners needs. During circle time we will be developing our vocabulary and use of tense while we speak to each other.
