Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform you that we have received confirmation that a member of your child's School Bubble has tested positive for Covid-19.

They presented no symptoms whilst attending school, but in line with Public Health guidance have now entered household isolation.

In accordance with government guidance, your child should now self-isolate for 14 days, until midnight on Friday 9 October 2020 as they have been identified as a close contact. Other household members do not need to self-isolate unless your child starts to display symptoms. Children can return to school on Monday 12 October 2020.

Should your child begin to show symptoms of Covid-19 they are eligible for testing. The most common symptoms for Covid-19 are:-

- 1) New high temperature – your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back, (you do not need to measure the temperature)
- 2) A new continuous cough, coughing a lot for more than an hour or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- 3) A loss of, or changes to, their sense of smell or taste.

I can assure you that the school are vigilant in following government and local authority guidance.

The school remains open to other children.
