

#### 'Coast to Coast'




## Key book




In maths, we will be looking at fractions including halves, quarters and thirds. We will be identifying, comparing, ordering and counting fractions.



## Maths

## Coast to Coast

Our topic this term is all about coasts. We will begin by comparing seaside holidays to those from the past and exploring the impact that the development of the railway had on British holidays. We will then move onto learning about coasts from around the UK and identifying their geographical features.

## Animals Including Humans

In science, we will be focussing on animals and humans. We will be thinking about the basic needs of living things and the different types of animals. We will also look at skeletons and how we can keep our bodies healthy through healthy eating and exercise.

## RE

Our RE lessons this term are all about questions. We will be exploring possible answers to lots of 'big' questions about life, such as 'How was the world created?' 'Who is God?' 'Why do religious people think we should care for the world?' and many more. We will be considering how people from different religions find answers to these 'big' questions and thinking about our own thoughts on these questions about life.



## PSHE

In PSHE we will be looking at 'healthy relationships.' This will involve looking at how to keep ourselves safe, putting ourselves in other people's shoes and learning how to respect ourselves and others.



## Computing

In our computing lessons this half term, we will be developing our programming skills using 'Turtle Logo' and 'Scratch Jnr.' We will be using different codes to draw regular shapes and patterns. We will also look at how to correct our codes when the completed action is different to what we intended.

Get out the needle and thread- in DT we will be developing our sewing skills. We will be linking this to our topic by doing some coast themed textiles.
