Visit to Hornsea Inshore Rescue and Beach Clean

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our curriculum studies we have arranged a visit to Hornsea Inshore Rescue and Hornsea Beach to care for our environment on Tuesday 20th July 2021. We felt it important to mark the end of a challenging year with a curriculum visit for our children.

During the visit, the children will be participating in a beach clean accompanied by members of Hornsea Inshore Rescue. PPE will be provided, and the children will be using the litter picking equipment donated as part of our Global Learning letter writing.

- We will be departing from school at approximately 10.30 am and returning to school at approximately 3.30 pm.
- The children will need to wear their school uniform.
- Please provide your child with a sun hat and a water bottle and apply sun cream at the start of the day and because we cannot guarantee the weather a waterproof coat would be advisable.
- Transport will be provided by Aklams Travel.
- Please provide a packed lunch in disposable wrapping (no chocolate, glass bottles, fizzy drinks etc). The children will be eating their lunch on the beach.
- Insurance is covered under the Ebor Academy Trust Risk Protection Arrangement with the DofE. Details are available on request.
- Please notify us of any special medical considerations, including travel sickness and provide inhalers where required.

- School visits are an important part of the way in which we support your child’s learning. As you know, we rely heavily on the help of our parents in supporting us. We are therefore asking for a contribution towards the cost of the visit of £3. The cost is to help Hornsea Inshore Rescue to maintain the valuable service they give to our community. The PTFA have paid the cost of the transport and for each child to have an increase, we are very grateful for their support.
