


Key book this term

How can we interoperate pictures of religious expression in all its diversity, within and between religions



Maths


This term we are working on and developing our maths skills using the four operations of addition, subtraction, division and multiplication

Children will learn to explain their mathematical thinking and answer reasoning and problem solving questions

Humanities WW2

When pupils learn about WW2 they will focus on the political theme and investigate changes relating to the impact of the war on legal rights, power and governments.

Pupils will understand the significance of Hitler and understand that people can be seen as significant even if they are for bad reasons (E.g. Hitler compared with Martin Luther King) Pupils will consider how deeply people's lives have been affected, how many lives have been affected and for how long people's lives been
