Breakfast club runs from 8am and sessions are £2.50.

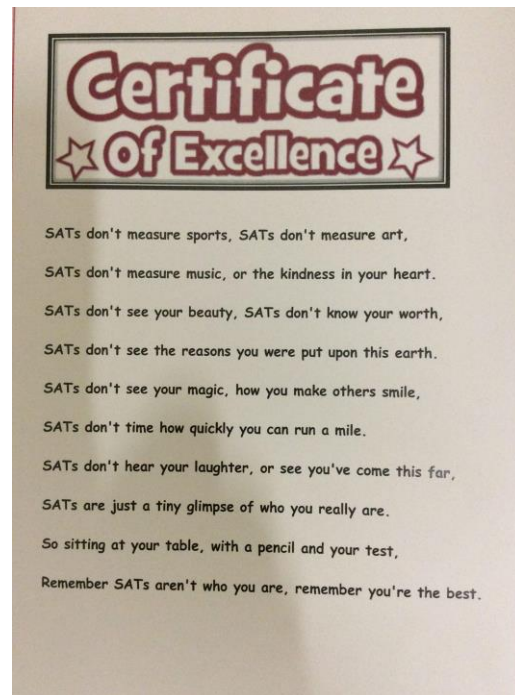
## PE Kits
