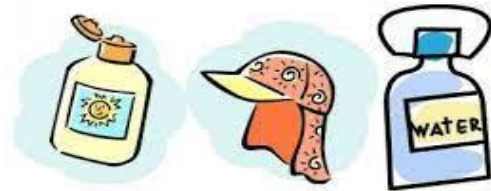
The Youth Club is next on Wednesday 14th June and 28th June.
