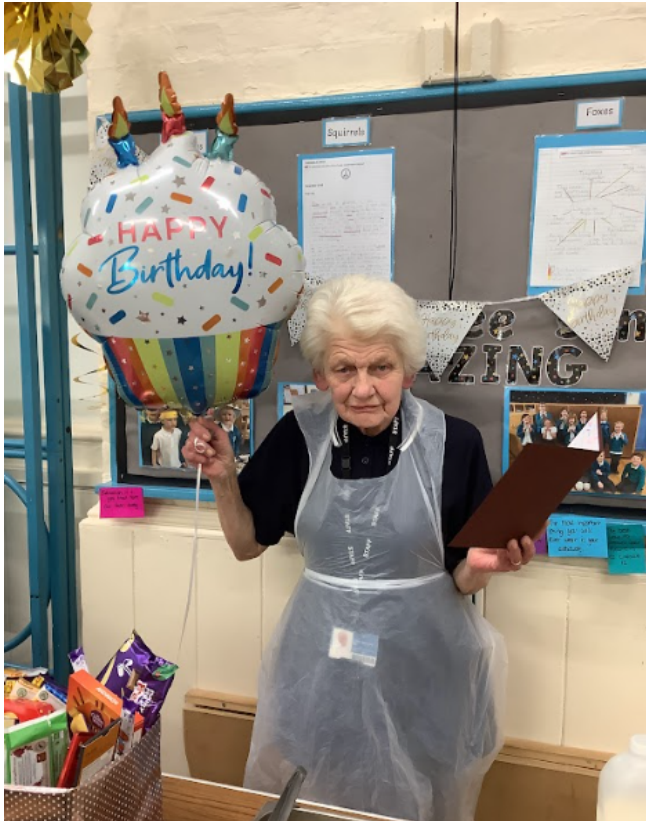
### Squirrels Violin Taster Session

Rev David is running a Youth Club for the Y5 and 6 children in Riston Village Hall from 7.00pm

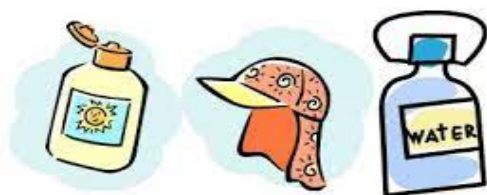
