Water Bottles

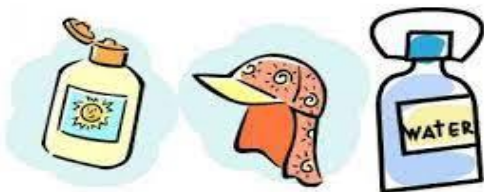


Please ensure your child's water bottle is water and not juice. This will help protect their teeth as they grow and develop.
