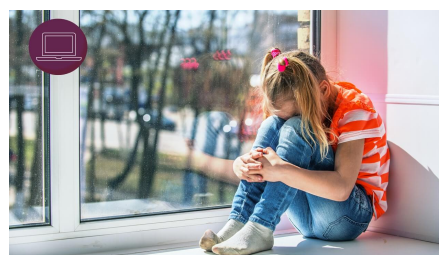
Youth Club
