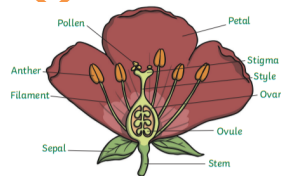
Can we successfully use a negative character as our main protagonist?

Why is pollination important?



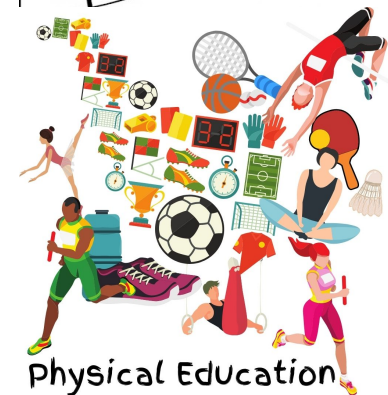
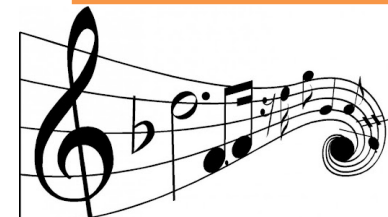
Maths

This term we are working on our rapid recall of multiplication facts. Relying on this knowledge to support our work in division.

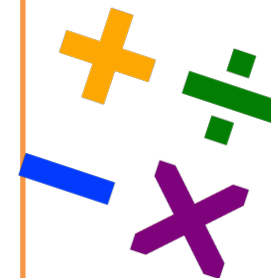
We will be following the Maths NCETM program to develop our knowledge and understanding of different mathematical concepts. The children will develop their fluency knowledge, skills of problem solving and reasoning, using different techniques including the use of practical resources.
