

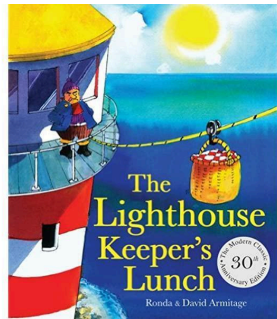

'Oh I Do Like To Be Beside The Seaside.'

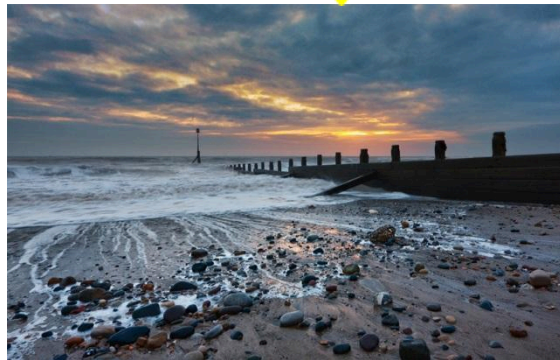
Key book



This term we will be looking at the 'Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch.' We will be writing setting descriptions and using the text to help us write our own stories. We will also be writing instructions for our own disgusting sandwiches. We will continue with our phonics scheme 'Little Wandle' and also with our daily guided reading sessions.

Oh I Do Like To Be Beside The Seaside

Our topic this term is all about the seaside. We will begin our topic by looking at seaside locations around the UK and identifying their human and physical features. We will also think about when seaside holidays became popular and what they looked like in the past.



Maths

In Maths, we will continue to look at the four operations. We will also learn about time, fractions and statistics. Year 2 will be practising their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Science- Plants

Our science topic this term is all about plants. We will be identifying plants and labelling the features. Then, thinking about what plants need to stay healthy and looking at plant life cycles. We will investigate the conditions that different plants need to be able to grow.



Art

In art this term will be looking at the artist and nature sculptor 'Andy Goldsworthy.' We will be using clay to create our own sculptures based on his work. We will also be creating land art out of natural resources.





RE

Christian Values- Friendship (Summer 01) and Respect (Summer 02)

Our RE focus this term is all about 'Worship.' We will be looking at how we worship as a school and plan our own worship based on our Christian values. We will consider where Christians and Jews worship and look at what happens in both a church and a synagogue. We will also look at types of prayer and think about how Christians use gospels to show them the right way.



Computing

Our computing sessions this term will focus on our programming skills. We will look at how programmes follow a sequence of instructions and what happens when the order changes. We will design our own algorithms and begin to learn how to debug programs.

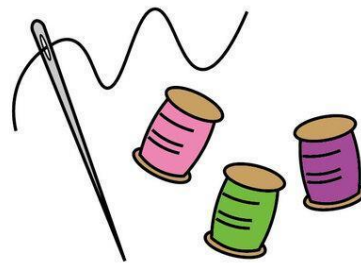


PE will continue to be on a Thursday and Friday afternoon.
