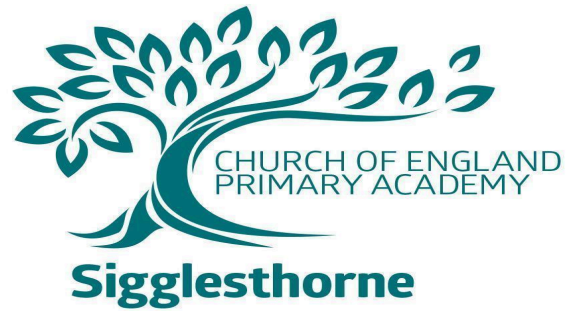

I hope that you have all enjoyed a fantastic Easter break and been able to enjoy some of the brighter weather.

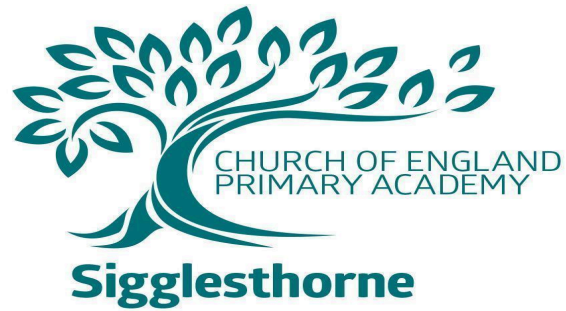

### **Mobile Phones**

Smart watches and mobile phones should not be brought into school. If a child is walking to and from school (Year 5&6 only) and has a phone for this purpose, it must be given to the school office to be locked away until 15.30pm.

### **Uniform & Attendance**

There have been no changes to either of our policies. However, please support the staff team in providing the best education for your child and support our school in maintaining its high standards by ensuring that your child is at school each day, on time and in the correct school uniform and with school PE kit for sport activities.

- Please ensure all uniforms are clearly named.
- Black school shoes are worn and trainers provided for P.E.
- Please ensure your child has a Forest School kit (not PE kit) in school.

Please remember **gates are open from 8.45am** and being in school at this time means your child has an extra 75 minutes per week of learning time, over a school year this is an extra 37.5 hours of learning for your child.

**After 9am** - All children arriving after 9am will need to be signed in on the Inventory system (the computer) in reception with a reason given for arriving late.

Footwear should be black unless there is a medical reason for a different pair of shoes.

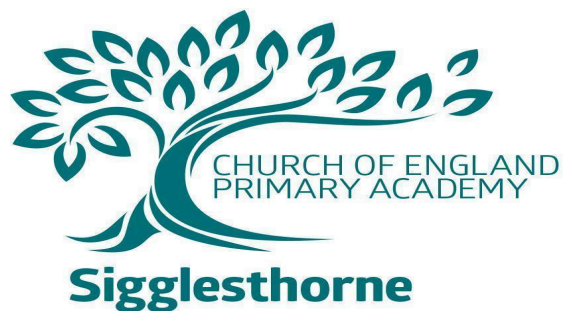
